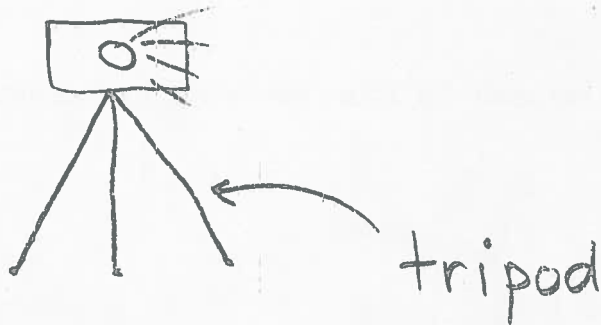

Monday - Choose a word from the list and draw a picture that shows what the word means. For example, draw a bike with an arrow pointing to the pedal.



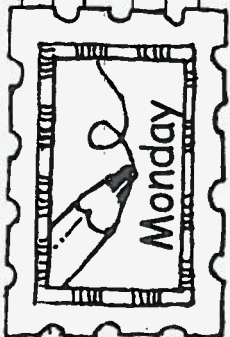
Tuesday - Use each spelling word in a sentence. Sentences should be no less than 7 words.

pedestrian (n)	a person who walks across the street on foot
pedicure (n)	a foot treatment that could include soaking the feet and polishing the toenails
quadruped (n)	a four- footed creature
tripod (n)	a three- footed stand often used to balance a camera

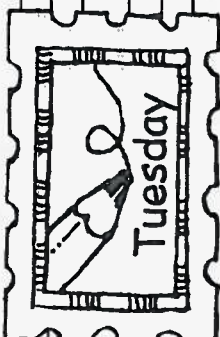
